Report to Cambrian School District Board of Trustees

As required by the statutes and bylaws of the Measure R Bond Election, the Citizens' Oversight Committee is pleased to provide our annual report to the Board of Trustees of the Cambrian School District. Members of the committee are Debbie Abbott, Lucy Johansen, Kirsten Reilly, Sam Shiraishi, and Brian Tanger.

On October 16, 2023, the committee met to discuss the current Measure R projects and prepare the annual report to the school board. Dr. John Pappalardo of Cambrian School District and Rick Kramer of RGM Kramer presented the annual Financial and Performance Audits for FY 21-22 dated June 30, 2022 for review. Cheryl Demeyer of RGM Kramer, Inc. presented a status of the current projects and shared that the Phase 1 Modernization projects at Price MS, Bagby ES, Fammatre ES, Farnham ES, and Sartorette ES are complete, with new construction for the New Modular Classrooms projects at Price MS, Fammatre ES, Farnham ES, and Sartorette ES in progress. Construction on the new classrooms is anticipated to continue until late spring 2024.

The committee reviewed the Invoice Summary by Project report for the period of May 1, 2020 through August 31, 2023. The report indicated that \$30,389,052.44 in Measure R invoices have been processed since the inception of Measure R.

The committee then discussed preparation of the annual report to the school board.

Based on our review and observations, the Citizens' Oversight Committee finds that the District is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIIIA, Section 1(b)(3) of the California Constitution and that funds are being used for the purposes specified in the ballot language.
