



What have we been up to?


Farnham Priorities 2021:

- ★ Social and emotional learning (recognizing and managing emotions, caring about others, making good decisions, developing positive relationships)
- ★ Positive culture programs (restorative justice, social justice, bullying prevention, positive behavior interventions and supports)
- ★ Mental health services (school counselors, school psychologists, therapists)

- ★ All classrooms are using Second Step Curriculum to support social emotional competence and self regulation
- ★ All classrooms are using Zones of Regulation to support students understanding their own emotions/feelings and how to recognize and regulate themselves
- ★ Counselors on site 3 days a week
