

### **Dear Parents and Neighbors:**

Cambrian School District (CSD), is committed to maintaining the high quality of our neighborhood schools. Our teachers educate over 3,000 students in four elementary schools, one comprehensive middle school, and a K-8 STEAM Magnet school. Exceptional teachers, small class sizes, challenging instructional programs, dedicated parent volunteers, and outstanding science, math, art and music curricula have prepared generations of local children to succeed in high school, college, and careers. **Our goal is to continue that proud tradition.** 

We appreciate the generous support from our community. The level of school funding provided by the state of California is one of the lowest in the nation. We rely on local funding to fill in the gap. Fortunately, local voters have generously supported CSD, voting to pass Measure H, a parcel tax, in 2018 to protect and maintain the local quality of education.

Measure H for Cambrian School District is a parcel tax of \$94.24 per-parcel/year which supports Transitional Kindergarten through eighth grade students by attracting and retaining quality teachers, continuing core programs in math, science, engineering, technology, reading, music and the arts, maintaining class sizes, and providing physical education programs that promote student health and fitness.

Without Measure H, the Cambrian School District annual budget would need to be cut by nearly a million dollars. This would force all Cambrian schools to make drastic cuts to academic programs, increase class sizes, and maintain only basics. Continuing Measure H won't address all funding needs, but it will help retain exceptional teachers and protect core programs.

### NEW SCHOOL YEAR New Opportunities

The 2023-24 school year began back in August for students in the Cambrian School District, and we've seen outstanding achievement, committed staff teaching a robust curriculum to our youth, and families passionate about partnering with us to see learning and growth.

### **Measure R Update**

The Modernization Project has been in full swing, working on facility repairs, upgrades, and improvements to Bagby, Farnham, Fammatre, Price and Sartorette. We have been preparing our sites for construction of new classrooms and this first phase focused on installation of necessary infrastructures such

as grading, plumbing, electrical and ADA accessibility improvements. We also have new air conditioning units in the Price Science buildings.

Our sites will remain under construction during the school year. The construction fencing is being adjusted from the summer work size to the school year work size. Modular classrooms will be completed in May/June of next year.

Living under construction is a test on our patience and comes with the need to adjust and be flexible, but the end result is always worth it! We are lucky to live in such a supportive community.

### **Grants From Local Benefactors**



### Price Middle School's Mental Health program awarded by NAMI, in SJMN

**HONOR ROLL:** Price Middle School in San Jose's Cambrian School District will receive the Community Merit Award from the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) for its efforts to create awareness around mental health issues. In the past three years, Price School has raised \$30,000 for NAMI, including \$10,000 at its third annual Price Walk for Mental Health last October. The entire student body of more than 900 kids participated along with more than 85 staff members.
