California Department Education Monitoring

- California Department of Education in the second year of monitoring school districts implementation of students' Individual Education Program (IEP), and timelines for completion of IEPS.
- Price Middle School is in year 2 of targeted Compliance Improvement Monitoring (CIM) for least restrictive environment and attendance.

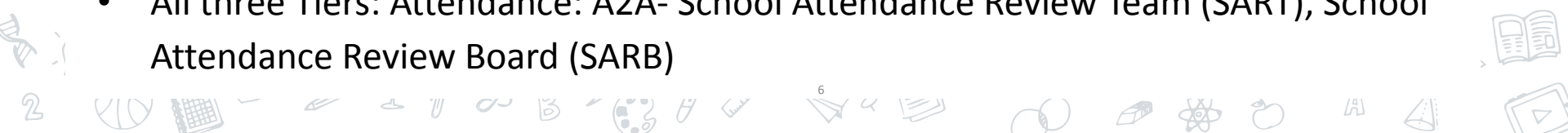
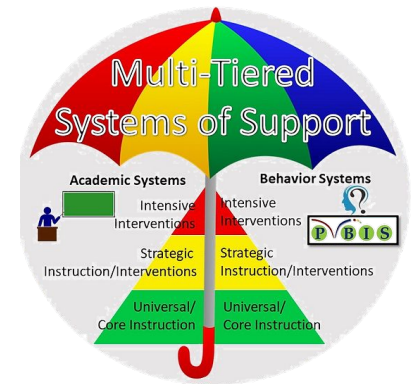
Multi-Tiered Systems of support

Social Emotional Learning

- Tier 1 : Zones of Regulation, Second Step, and Habitudes in General Education, Restorative Practices, Kelvin, Attendance conferences and written communication
- Tier 2 : Counseling Services (individual/group), Care Solace, Kelvin, SART attendance meetings
- Tier 3: Behavioral Intervention Plans, SARB attendance process

Behavioral

- Tier 1: PBIS Lessons, Schoolwide Rewards, Kelvin
- Tier 2: Kelvin, Behavior Services
- Tier 3: Behavioral Services, Individualized supports by area of growth
- All three Tiers: Attendance: A2A- School Attendance Review Team (SART), School Attendance Review Board (SARB)

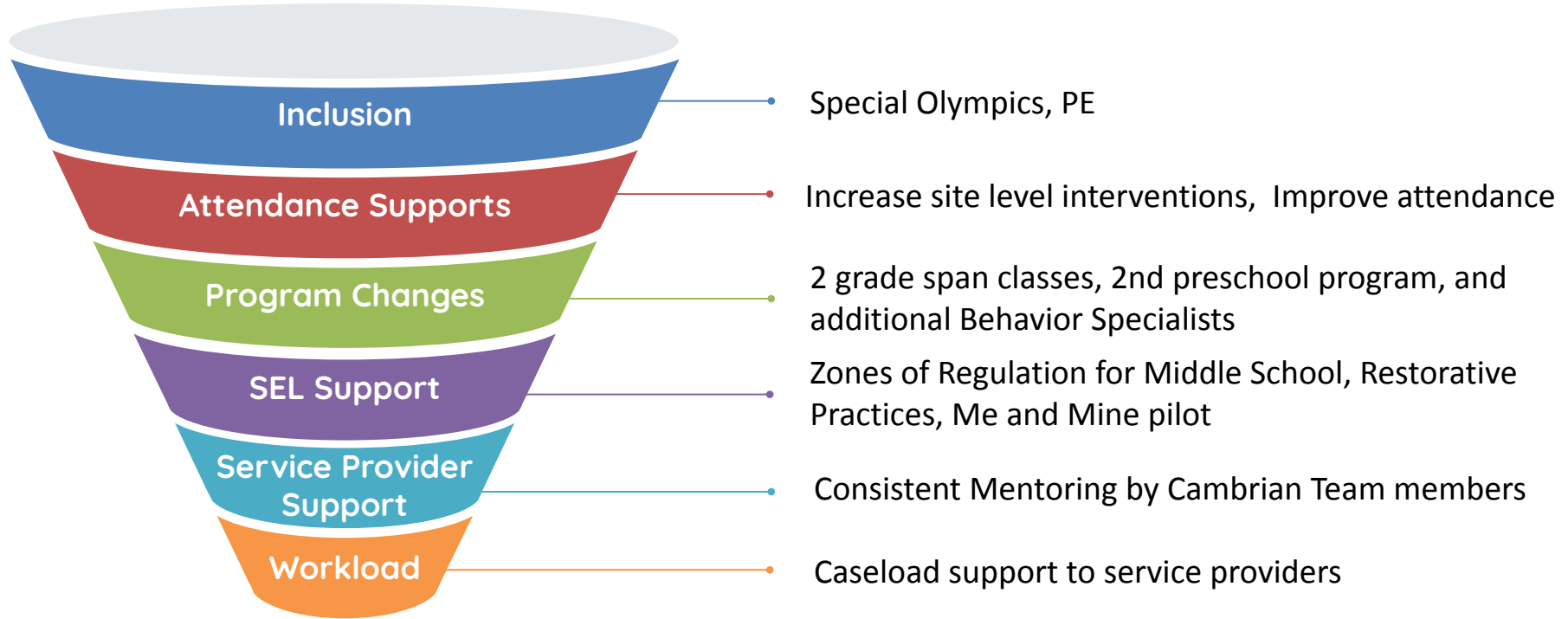

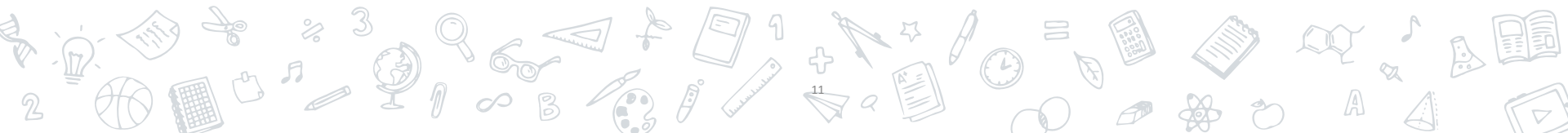
