What is the Consolidated Application?

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- » The Consolidated Application (ConApp) is used by the California Department of Education (CDE) to distribute categorical funds from various state and federal programs to the District.
- » Annually, in June, CSD submits the **spring** release of the application to document participation in these programs and provide assurances that the District will comply with the legal requirements of each program. Program entitlements are determined by formulas contained in the laws that created the programs.
- » The **winter** release of the application is submitted in February of each year and contains the District entitlements for each funded program. Out of each state and federal program entitlement, the District allocates funds for indirect costs of administration, for programs operated by the district office, and for programs operated at schools.

The Local Control Accountability Plan, Federal Addendum and Consolidated Application

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- » The **Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)** is a state plan that meets the **Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)** requirements
- » The **LCAP Federal Addendum**, in combination with the **Consolidated Application (Con App)** meets the requirements for **Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)**
- » Both are **aligned** and **connected** to funding sources.

What is TA Title I Program?

- » Less than 40 percent of the students enrolled in the school are from low-income families.
- » Developed a process to determine which eligible students who are failing, or most at-risk of failing, to meet grade level academic standards.
- » Provide additional services which may include programs, activities, strategies, interventions and courses that necessary to provide a well-rounded education and are evidence-based.

Examples of Supplemental Programs & Services

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Supplementing occurs when federal funds **enhance** existing state or local funds for program activities.

The supplement, not supplant provision requires that **federal grant funds must add to** (or supplement) **and not replace** (or supplant) other funds (state/local) in providing general educational service.

- » Services that address barriers to learning – for English learners, homeless and foster youth, and low income students
- » Staff professional development
- » Academic support
- » Enrichment learning opportunities
- » Mental health & counseling services
- » Curriculum/materials
- » Personnel costs for crisis intervention and family support
- » Parent education programs and services
