7. ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 7.1 Mrs. Presunka announced that Tuesday, November 2nd is a professional development day for Cambrian teachers. The professional development day will allow for collaboration and joint work amongst teachers to support student learning.

9.1 <u>Measure R: Change Orders 3D, 4B, 4G, 5C, 6A, and 6E - Phase 1 Modernization Projects</u>: Cheryl Demeyer from RGM Kramer Inc., presented the change orders in connection with the Phase 1 Modernization Project to replace the aging HVAC systems at Bagby, Fammatre, Farnham, Sartorette, and Price Middle School.

9.2 Measure R: Construction Management Contract Amendment #3: Mr. Rick Kramer from RGM Kramer Inc., presented the third amendment for Construction Management Services. Bagby: \$120,000 Price: \$60,000 Fammatre: \$40,000 Sartorette: \$20,000

Farnham: \$40,000

9.3 2021-22 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress Results for Grades 3-8: Mr. Linh Nguyen, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, provided an update on the 2021-22 Cambrian School District's California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) results. The CAASPP Assessment utilizes computer-based tests based on the California State Standards for English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA) and Mathematics He reviewed the overall student participation and student performance over the last five years. Cambrian continues to meet and exceed State standards.
