




Bagby Fall 2023 Early Reading (K-1)




Bagby Fall 2023 Early Math (K-1)

Bagby Fall 2023 LCAP Update Goal #1: What is working well?

- 1. Grade Level Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)
 - a. Principal, Instructional Specialist, Teacher leadership partnership
 - b. Foundation established for grade level data driven collaboration
 - i. Teachers using data to monitor student learning and identifying strategic interventions--100% Progress Monitoring Target Students
 - c. Incorporation of Intervention Team in PLCs has increased collaboration, improved strategic interventions
 - i. Nuanced, conversations in support of individual students across settings
- 2. Small Group Instruction/Classroom Interventions
 - a. A focus of PLC-essential intervention instruction in Classroom
- 3. Ed. Services Support & Guidance
 - a. Instructional Specialist on-site support of:
 - i. Instructional practices (lesson modeling, curriculum expertise, new teacher support and follow through of district and site expectations)
 - On-going support for Intervention teachers and program
 - iii. Partnership in planning and delivering PLCs with Principal and PLC leadership team
- Tier II Strategic Intervention Team
 - a. All Some Risk/High Risk students from FB have been assessed with additional Quick Phonics Assessment and Quick Spelling Assessment for upper grades
 - b. Better tailored interventions offered to 40 students
 - c. More students served and the interventions are tailored to specific skills/needs
- **5.** ELD Extended Learning Academy
 - a. Two Programs in place daily supporting 10 students (ELPAC scores 1-2)

Bagby Fall 2023 LCAP Update Goal #1: Next Steps

- 1. Continue Cycles of Inquiry & Strategic Classroom Interventions
 - a. Data driven, small group Tier 1 interventions (within classrooms)
 - b. Focus on supports for Hispanic/Latino & EL students due to persistent achievement gaps-CAASPP & FastBridge Assessments
 - c. Teacher accountability with interventions
 - d. More opportunities for collaboration with SpEd (RSP,Speech,OT,Behavior Therapist,Counseling)
- 2. Regular Instructional Walkthrough
 - a. Implementation of standardized data collection tool
 - b. Discussion of observed trends and next steps during staff meetings
- 3. Focus on GLAD Strategies-Support of ELD/All Students
 - a. Regular Implementation in all classes
 - i. Strategy a Month presented in Staff Meeting with follow up
 - ii. Staff input to scaffold support based on need and GLAD experience
- 4. Provide release time for peer classroom visits-PLC Feedback
 - Focused visits to observe instructional practices/interventions identified by grade levels during PLCs

Professional Development In:

- Benchmark Phonics Intervention
 - a. All instructional staff trained
 - b. Continued planning and collaboration during implementation
- 2. Science Curriculum Piloting
 - a. Discussions with staff regarding options, needs, and questions.
 - b. Following adoption-robust PD in preparation for implementation August 2024
- ELD/GLAD Strategies-Support of ELD/All Students
 - a. Regular GLAD Implementation in all classes (scaffolded for staff)
 - b. Designated ELD Benchmark curriculum
- 4. Continuing On-Going PD/Support for FastBridge Interventions
 - Focused visits to observe and model instructional practices/interventions identified by grade levels during PLCs
 - b. Supporting upper grade with phonic and phonemic awareness interventions
- 5. Instructional Specialist collaboration with Reading Specialist
 - a. Tailored training on team collaboration days TK-2, 3-5
 - b. Focus on improving literacy school-wide

 - PBIS Expectation Field Trips
- 3. Maintained Recess Support Ratios & VS Activities at Lunchtime Recess

 - On-Going communication to provide all staff with information, context, and guidance on how to support students
 - Dynamic response to student needs requires personnel
 - i. Supports CAN'T wait for system
 - . <u>Behavior Specialist and Paraeducator support</u>

Fall 23 Student Survey Results [2nd-5th]

237 Student Responses (2nd-5th, 2nd Added for Fall '23) Survey Response Options: Always/Often/Rarely/Never Spring 23→Fall 23

<u>Survey Changes</u>: Sometimes⊸Rarely

- I like going to school at Bagby-83%→97%
- My teachers and Bagby staff want me to do well-98%→99%
- I try my best to do well in school-93%→97%
- Bagby has clear expectations for behavior-90%→98%
- Good behavior is noticed at Bagby-65%→91%
- Teachers/Staff Members treat me with respect-89%→98%
- I get along with other students and have friends at Bagby-87%,96%
- I feel safe at Bagby-84%→95%
- Students treat each other well-64%→94%
- There are adults at Bagby who will help me if I need it-87%→98%
 - I feel heard when I talk to a teacher or staff member at Bagby-76%
 →90%
- I feel included at Bagby-78%→93%

Bagby Fall 2023 LCAP Update Goal #3: Next Steps-Building off the progress

- 1. Complete PBIS Reboot
 - a. Create additional systems for acknowledging students making positive choices
- 2. Continue SWIS data updates during Staff collaboration
 - a. Identify trends and strategically reteach expectations as needed
- Lunchtime Activities
 - a. Expanding alternative lunchtime activities to utilize extended day facility-indoor games, STEM/Art related activities
- 4. Supervision Staff
 - a. Maintain present supervision ratios and provide additional support and training based on behavior trends
- Establishing Varied After School Opportunities (ELOP Funds)
 - a. Starting Arts After School-started in October
 - b. Provide additional offerings based on Spring '23 Surveys
- **6.** Chronic Absenteeism Support
 - a. Work with Student Services to explore options in supporting chronic absenteeism
 - i. Transportation needs to be considered
- 7. Supports for High Level Student Behavior
 - Ongoing partnership with CSDs Behavioral Specialists, Paraeducators, Teachers, additional staff, and Families
- Providing Critical Supports In Partnerships w/HSC & Student Supports
 - a. Bagby Cares & Student Services Resources/Connections

Community Climate Spring 2023 Survey Results

- My child likes school overall-90.0%
- My child feels included at school-88.0%
- I feel welcome coming onto campus-90.0%
- I am comfortable reaching out to staff-89.7%
- Satisfaction with Goal Setting Conferences-92.0%

Spring School Climate Survey Results Areas for Improvement

- Require Spring conferences or require follow-up to goal setting conferences
- School/CSD Newsletters NOT mobile friendly
- More advanced notice for volunteering-32%
- More flexible hours for volunteering-30%
- I feel that there are no barriers to me being able to volunteer-54%
- More cultural events-62%

- 1. How do we welcome families new to Bagby
 - a. Build off success of revamped TK/Kindergarten orientation in August
 - b. Explore how HSC can welcome new families
 - Welcoming committee members
- **2.** Explore bringing cultural celebrations in partnership with HSC
- 3. From Survey Community (Spring 23)-Family information sessions are demanded
 - Parenting, Digital Citizenship, Supporting Reading & language acquisition
- 4. Revamp Website & Electronic Communication Tools
- **5.** Exploring more effective family classroom/grade level communication to facilitate more social connections
- **6.** Work with Student Services to explore options in supporting chronic absenteeism in SED & SPED students/families
 - a. Transportation support provided to broader
