What is the CA School Dashboard?

The California School Dashboard is an **online tool** designed to help communities across the state access **important information** about kindergarten through grade twelve **schools and districts**. The Dashboard features easy-to-read reports on **multiple measures of school success**.

2023 Dashboard Overview

- The 2023 Dashboard reflects data from the **2022–23 school year**.
- The 2023 Dashboard includes **state indicators and local indicators**. State indicators are derived from data submitted via the California Longitudinal Pupil Data System (CALPADS) and published on the Dashboard. Local indicators are based on data collected and reported by Districts.
- The 2023 Dashboard provides a **second data point** after the COVID-19 pandemic. This is important information about the effectiveness of learning acceleration efforts and other programs implemented to support student success.
- The 2023 Dashboard results **should be used in conjunction with other local data on student performance and progress**, such as progress reports, student work, and teacher feedback. The combination of state and local data provides a more detailed picture of strengths as well as areas of opportunity.
- **Important Note:** The official published results on the CA Dashboard for **Cambrian SD only represents Bagby School & Steindorf K-8 results combined**. CSD's Charters (Fammatre, Farnham, Sartorette and Price) are represented as individual Local Educational Agencies (LEAs).


2023 CA Dashboard State & Local Indicators

The 2023 Dashboard will include the following **State Indicators**:

- **Academic Indicators**
 - **English Language Arts/Literacy**
 - **Mathematics**
- **English Learner Progress Indicator (ELPI)**
- **Chronic Absenteeism Indicator**
- **Suspension Rate Indicator**
- Graduation Rate Indicator (High School ONLY)
- College/Career Indicator (High School ONLY)


Also includes **Local Indicators**:

- Basic Services, Implementation of Academic Standards, Parent & Family Engagement, Local School Climate, and Access to Broad Course of Study.



CA Dashboard Performance Levels

Five Performance Levels (Colors)



Two years of data (Status and Change) are required to receive a performance level (color):

- **Status:** Current year data
- **Change:** Difference between current and prior year data



CA Dashboard Focus on Equity

- **Equity** is at the heart of California’s accountability system.
- The Dashboard identifies **performance gaps among student groups through its equity reports**, which are available for each state measure.
- The equity report **shows the number of student groups placed in each Performance Level** (or color) for a particular state measure.

Note: Because the **English Learner Progress Indicator** only contains one student group (i.e., English Learners), this state measure does not have an equity report.

Qualifying for Additional Support

- Based on results from the Dashboard, California determines which LEAs (including charter schools) and schools are eligible for additional support. This support includes **Differentiated Assistance (DA), Comprehensive School Improvement (CSI), or Additional Targeted School Improvement (ATSI)**.
- **Eligibility criteria are based upon the performance of student groups on the state indicators.**
- The County Office of Education is to provide customized and individualized technical assistance to our schools and district as needed.
- The County Office of Education will have communicated with our schools and district about areas that need extra attention.
- Notification for CSI & ATSI is still pending.

Differentiated Assistance

For LEAs to be eligible for differentiated assistance, the same student group must meet the criteria in two different State Priority Areas.

- Student group performance in two or more Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) state priority areas, or
- Performance on local indicators in two or more priority areas, or
- A combination of student group performance in one state priority area and local indicator performance in one different priority area.

The eligibility criteria for charter schools is the same as for districts except charter schools have to meet the criteria in two years.

Results from the 2022 and 2023 Dashboards are used in differentiated assistance determinations.

Based on the 2023 CA Dashboard, Price Middle School is eligible for Differentiated Assistance under Ed Code 47607.3 (Charter Eligibility).

Specifically, Price met eligibility criteria as indicated in the table below:
