9. INFORMATION AND STUDY ITEM

9.1 <u>Facilities: Additional Classrooms at Steindorf Update:</u> Mr. Mark Finney from Finney Architects and Superintendent Schwiebert shared the revised classroom layout for the additional classrooms at Steindorf. The District wishes to increase the classroom layout size to 60' x 40' from 48' x 40' to better meet the future needs of the District. The estimated cost would increase to \$2,287,00.

ACTION: On a motion by Trustee Villalobos, seconded by Trustee Gillis, the Board approved the larger modular classrooms and increase the estimated total amount to \$2,287,00. Motion **CARRIED** 5-0

9.2 <u>Consolidated Application Part I 2023-24</u>: Mr. Linh Nguyen, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, presented the Consolidated Application (ConApp). The ConApp is used by the California Department of Education to distribute categorical funds from various state and federal programs to school districts. Mr. Nguyen reviewed the programs and their projected allocations.

ACTION: On a motion by Trustee Villalobos, seconded by Trustee Middleton, the Board approved the Consolidated Application, Part I for 2023-24. Motion **CARRIED** 5-0

The resolution declares that Cambrian School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
