Project Prioritization Recap

- Measure R Phase 1 project budgets totaling \$13.57M for classroom HVAC, gas lines at Price MS and two marquees were approved on 2/22/21.
- On 3/18/21 the board was presented with a list of approximately \$100M of projects (in 2021 dollars) for discussion and advised the board to prioritize Tier 1 projects from the list totaling \$48.5M (in 2021 dollars) = \$60.4M (estimate with cost escalation) and maintain an unallocated program level contingency of \$17.7M. (or possibly \$12.5M)

Project Prioritization Recap

- On 3/18/21 staff also advised that contingency projects (Tier 2) should be prioritized as well, should any ofthe program contingency remain available as the program progresses.
- On 5/6/21 Staff presented an option to only replace the 20 oldest District portables leaving 10 existing on the school sites, Price MS (replace 5 of 5), Fammatre ES (replace 5 of 5), Farnham ES (replace 5 of 8), Sartorette ES (replace 5 of 8), Bagby ES (replace 0 of 4).
- Board requested staff provide a future enrollment projection to help make the decision on portable replacements.

DSA IR EB-4 Seismic Upgrades

- DSA IR EB-4 establishes construction cost trigger point at which full seismic upgrades to existing classroom buildings must occur if modernized.
- The new update to DSA IR EB-4 sets threshold much lower than prior instruction.
- We need to conduct a structural engineering survey of our existing classroom buildings and set aside contingency funds for seismic upgrades in our modernization projects.
- Proposal for survey to be submitted for approval at 6/17 board meeting.



Board survey on project priority

- Review board project priority survey spreadsheet.
- 24 total projects were identified as a priority by members of the board.
- Some level of modernization to existing classrooms at Price, Bagby, Fammatre, Farnham and Sartorette is a priority to all 5 board members.
- Replacing at least some existing portables with permanent construction is a priority for 4 board members.



- Repairs or replacements of underground utilities are a priority of 3 board members.
- Touchless faucets and toilets are a priority of 3 board members.
- 8 other projects are a priority of at least 2 board members.

Continue Measure R project prioritization

- Project prioritization ultimate goal: Approve two tiers of projects, provide direction to proceed with scheduling and development of the Tier 1 projects.
 - Tier 1 projects of approximately \$74M will be completed under Measure R.
 - Some of the Tier 2 projects would be completed to the extent that \$12.5M of the program level contingency remains unused.
 - Tier 3 projects would not be completed in the Measure R program.
 - Review project list for discussion, questions, direction.
