Red Tier Reopening



- Santa Clara County moved into the Red Tier. Wednesday, March 3, is the first day, that all K-12 schools are eligible to reopen in the County.
- In the Red Tier, School Districts have three (3) weeks to reopen for in person instruction, even if county returns back to purple tier during those three (3) weeks. (March 3rd - March 24th)
