17% of our students are identified English Learners.




Fammatre was identified as a Title I Targeted Assistance Program School.

Historical CAASPP Data









Goal 1: High Academic Achievement



2024 Spring aReading Fastbridge scores for 3rd-5th graders indicated 70.92% were on/above or low risk.



2024 Spring aMath Fastbridge scores for 3rd-5th graders indicated 74.01% were on/above or low risk.


What to do next:

- 1) Expand data points through additional curriculum based assessments.
- 2) Regularly use the data during Grade Level collaboration and PLCs to guide instruction.
- Start afterschool ELD program earlier in the year and create multilevel programs to support ELD at all levels.
- 4) Continue with Instructional Specialist coaching.
- 5) Continue weekly support staff meetings and tighten up our SST processes.
- 6) Develop math interventions.

- Collaborated with staff to develop PLC and monitors data.


Goal 2 continued

- Opened Student Store









- ELA scores for upper and lower grades are increasing.








- Need math interventions for upper grades.
- Discrepancy between Hispanic and Non-Hispanic students is evident in math as well.
