

HIGH ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ 2022 Fastbridge Data - 76% of our 2ND-5TH students scored low risk or on/above level in both reading and math
- ▶ Early Reading - 54% of our TK-1st students scored low risk
- ▶ Early Math - 67% of our TK-1st students scored low risk
- ▶ Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) for 1st-4th grade
 - ▶ 53 students served and 29 students exited
- ▶ Seven students served in our morning ELD class (Level 1)
- ▶ Seven students Reclassified Fluent English Proficient
- ▶ Professional Learning Communities (PLC)
 - ▶ Collective Teacher Efficacy
 - ▶ Fifth Grade 1/2 Hour Power Hour (literacy)
- ▶ GLAD strategies used in 100% of classrooms
- ▶ Maker projects school wide


HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Over 75% - I like school, I feel like I do well in school, good behavior is noticed at my school, students treat each other well
