### SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING AND SUPPORTS



#### **Positive Social and Emotional Learning**

**Objective:** To provide our students with positive social and emotional support strategies and restorative practices that promote prosocial behavior, ownership and accountability, goal setting, consistency and communication between student, guardian and Extended Day staff.

#### Supports:

- Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

-Extended Day Team attend 504 Support Team meetings at the invitation of student guardian and school site administration team and work in collaboration with teachers and site teams to provide consistency and support to students from the classroom to after school.

- Work with outside ABA therapy agencies providing push in support during Extended Day program.

-Support outside counseling services in providing counseling sessions.

- Held at Bagby, Fammatre, Farnham, Price, Sartorette and Steindorf School Sites.
- Student Enrollment: 719 Student Contracts (Increase of 109 contracts from prior year)
- 115 students attending Extended Day on full scholarship through ELO-P initiative.

## PROGRAM NEXT STEPS



<u>Preparations for Summer 2025 Program</u>-Work with Building and Grounds, Student Services and school site staff to plan summer program logistics. Registration opens March 1st.

<u>Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P)</u>-Continue to work in collaboration with Educational Services team in the ELO-P implementation in extended day program.

#### Preparations for 2025-2026 School Year Extended Day Program

-Registration will open on May 1st-August 1st. Contracts approved in order received.

-Continual program development, expansion and improvement. Support additional needs of TK students due to increase in TK student numbers and younger starting age.

- Implementation of Code Ablaze - Blazing the Path for Equal Opportunity and Rising Coders in middle school Extended Day program led by local high school students.

- 6% increase in program tuition for the 2025-2026 school year to support increased program costs. First cost increase since program beginning.

Cost comparison to neighboring school districts: Cambrian \$5600 (6% increase included), Moreland \$5662, Union \$5966, Saratoga \$6000, Campbell Union \$7190, Los Gatos Parks and Recreation \$7330
