**DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MEASURE BB ELECTION HELD ON
NOVEMBER 5, 2024, REQUESTING SANTA CLARA COUNTY TO CONTINUE
TO INCLUDE THE PARCEL TAX ON THE TAX ROLL, AND
OTHER RELATED ACTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the Cambrian School District (the “District”) called an education parcel tax election that was held on June 5, 2018, pursuant to Resolution No. 17-18-07 (the “2018 Election Resolution”), adopted on March 1, 2018;

WHEREAS, the education parcel tax measure (“Measure H”), which was fully described in the 2018 Election Resolution, was submitted to voters at the election and abbreviated on the ballot as follows:

MEASURE H: “To provide Cambrian neighborhood elementary and middle school students with stable funding for instruction in math, science, reading, engineering, technology, and arts; retain highly qualified teachers; and maintain class sizes; shall Cambrian School District establish an annual parcel tax of \$84 for 8 years, its continuance subject to voter approval, raising approximately \$740,000 in the first year, subject to annual adjustment; with exemptions for senior citizens, no funds for administrator’s salaries and every dollar benefitting Cambrian children?”

WHEREAS, Measure H was approved by more than sixty-seven percent (67%) of voters of the District voting on the measure pursuant to the terms set forth in Measure H (the “Parcel Tax”), exceeding the amount of votes required by Article XIII A, Section 4 of the California Constitution;

WHEREAS, as set forth in the text of the abbreviated ballot measure above and in the 2018 Election Resolution, Measure H was structured to continue the Parcel Tax unless and until voters have an opportunity to provide their opinion to the District, pursuant to California Elections Code section 9603, on whether or not to continue the Parcel Tax after fiscal year 2025-26;

WHEREAS, in the 2018 Election Resolution and as a part of the District’s Parcel Tax, the Board committed to accept and carry out the will of the voters pursuant to the results of a subsequent election, as described in Measure H and the 2018 Election Resolution;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the commitment and authority of Measure H and consistent with the District’s Parcel Tax, the Board called an election that was held on November 5, 2024 (the “2024 Election”) by way of its Resolution No. 23-24-11 (the “2024 Election Resolution”), adopted on June 20, 2024;

WHEREAS, consistent with the Parcel Tax, the measure to continue the Parcel Tax, which was fully described in the 2024 Election Resolution, was submitted to voters at the election and abbreviated on the ballot as follows:

MEASURE BB: “Advisory Vote Only. To continue to provide Cambrian neighborhood elementary and middle school students with stable funding for instruction in math, science, reading, engineering, technology, and arts, retaining highly qualified teachers, and maintaining manageable class sizes, should Cambrian School District continue the annual parcel tax that was approved by 67 percent of voters in 2018 (with no changes), with exemptions for seniors, no funds for administrators’ salaries, and every dollar benefitting Cambrian children?”

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County (the “Registrar”) has now duly canvassed the returns of the 2024 Election, as required by law and the Board’s 2024 Election Resolution;

WHEREAS, the Registrar has also filed with this Board a statement of all votes cast at the 2024 Election showing the whole number of votes cast in the District and the whole number of votes cast for and against Measure BB in the District, in each of the respective consolidated 2024 Election precincts therein, and by vote by mail voters;

WHEREAS, the Registrar has also filed, attached to the statement, a certificate as to the correctness of the statement;

WHEREAS, the Registrar has certified that seventy-seven percent (77%) of the votes cast on the District’s Measure BB were in favor of the continuation of the levy of the Parcel Tax, as described herein and consistent with the District’s Parcel Tax; and

WHEREAS, the Board now determines to direct the continued levy of the Parcel Tax, consistent with the will of the voters and the District’s Parcel Tax as described in Measure H, Measure BB, the 2018 Election Resolution, and the 2024 Election Resolution.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Cambrian School District, Santa Clara County, California, as follows:

- Section 1. Recitals.** This Board hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- Section 2. Confirmation of Canvass.** The canvass by the Registrar, as shown by the statement of all votes cast and the certificate of the Registrar, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A (the “Certificate of Election Results”), is hereby ratified, confirmed, approved and entered upon the minutes of this meeting of the District’s Board. Pursuant to the Certificate of Election Results, all ballots, including vote by mail ballots, have been duly received and canvassed in the time, form, and manner as required by law.
- Section 3. Votes Cast.** The total number of votes cast in the District at the 2024 Election and the total number of votes cast at each precinct, including vote by mail ballots, for and against the measure, is shown on Exhibit A attached hereto.

- Section 4. Measure Passed.** Seventy-seven percent (77%) of all the votes cast at the 2024 Election on Measure BB were in favor of the measure, exceeding the minimum threshold required, and Measure BB passed.
- Section 5. Certification of Proceedings.** This Board hereby certifies to the Board of Supervisors of the County that, to the best of this Board's knowledge, all proceedings of the District in connection with the 2024 Election for Measure BB have been accomplished according to the law.
- Section 6. Delivery of Certificate of Election Results.** This Board hereby authorizes District staff to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the County Superintendent of Schools and the Department of Controller-Treasurer of the County.
- Section 7. Exemptions to Parcel Tax.** As set forth in the 2024 Election Resolution, the Parcel Tax will continue to allow for an exemption to be granted for any parcel owned by one or more persons 65 years of age or over who occupies said parcel as a principal residence, upon application for exemption. All property that would otherwise be exempt from property taxes shall be exempt from the Parcel Tax.
- Section 8. Annual Adjustment.** As set forth in the 2024 Election Resolution, the Parcel Tax shall continue to be adjusted annually by the change in the Consumer Price Index (all urban consumers) for the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose Metropolitan Area, published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, or an equivalent index.
- Section 9. Request to Levy Parcel Tax.** Following the results of the 2024 Election, the Parcel Tax no longer has a termination date. Accordingly, this Board requests that the Department of Controller-Treasurer of the County continue to enroll the District's Parcel Tax on the tax roll for collection and distribution by the Department of Controller-Treasurer of the County following fiscal year 2025-26. This Board authorizes and directs District staff to do any and all things necessary or advisable in order to continue to enroll the Parcel Tax on the tax roll as set forth in this Section 9, including to execute and deliver any document, letter, certification, or agreement to the County in order to facilitate the continued levy of the Parcel Tax approved by the voters as set forth herein.
- Section 10. General Authorization.** The members of this Board, and the Superintendent and the Chief Financial Officer of the District, or their designees, are hereby authorized and directed, individually and collectively, to do any and all things necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution. All actions heretofore, or hereafter taken by such authorized officers and agents of the District that are in conformity with the purposes and intent of this Resolution are hereby ratified, confirmed, and approved in all respects.
