



# **Conditions and Status: Reopen for In-Person Instruction**

#### Why we Submitted COVID Safety Plan, COVID Prevention Plan and Checklist to CDPH by February 1?

- State mandated proposal to access one time monies proposal February 1 deadline to submit COVID Safety Plan, COVID Prevention Plan and Checklist
- CSD submitted COVID Safety Plan, COVID Prevention Plan and Checklist to ensure access to one time dollars per the Governor's Proposal if passed (Legislatures Decision-did not pass)
- We updated the Cambrian guidelines to reflect changes mandated by CDPH-sent to families/staff

#### <u>Complete a COVID Safety Plan which consists of two parts: Cal/OSHA COVID-19 Prevention Program and</u> <u>COVID-19 School Guidance Checklist (Cambrian Completed 2.1.21)</u>

- Post the COVID Safety Plan publicly on the website homepage at least 5 days prior to providing in-person instruction (*Cambrian Completed*, 2.1.21)
- Submit the COVID Safety Plan to the Santa Clara County Public Health Department and State Safe Schools (*Cambrian Completed*, 2.1.21)

# **Updates since February 4th Board Meeting**

- Current Adjusted Case Rate for Santa Clara County 10.9 (Purple Tier)
- Educator Vaccination Updates:
  - Beginning February 28, 2021, healthcare providers in Santa Clara County will expand vaccination to workers in the following industries: education and childcare, food and agriculture, and emergency services.
  - Notice sent to all Cambrian employees as to latest updates and where to sign up for vaccination.
- COVID-19 Testing for Staff Continues every Two Weeks
- Student COVID-19 Testing:
  - We will encourage families to get their child tested prior to returning in person.
  - Investigating the feasibility of implementation (cost, logistics and manpower).
- As staff and community are vaccinated we will continue to follow best practices of mask wearing, social distancing, and proper hand hygiene to lower the risk of COVID-19 transmission.
