He highlighted the unique situations about 2020-21 and reviewed the General Fund revenues versus expenses. Mr. Corl shared that carryover balance will eliminate Year 3's negative balance and create a sufficient balance of Reserve for Economic Uncertainties.

In doing this, the Board must declare that the appropriations for the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4.
